GOVERNMENT ADVOCACY

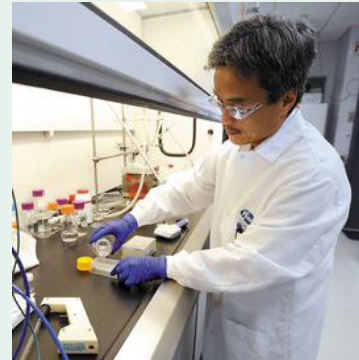

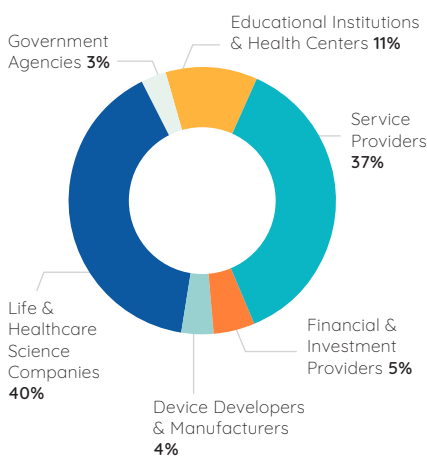
services, to continue to expand our ecosystem and the strength of our state economy.

MENTORING

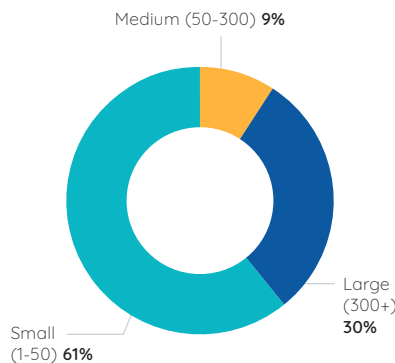
